Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Last week, Governor Tom Wolf announced that 13 additional counties, including Washington, would move into the yellow phase of reopening on Friday, May 15.

The yellow phase is the second of Pennsylvania's three-phase process to determine when counties are ready to begin easing some COVID-19 restrictions. This is not a full reopening; as counties move into the yellow phase, some restrictions on work and social interaction will ease while others, including limitations around gatherings of 25 people or more, will remain in place.

While some child care centers have been able to reopen, we are still waiting on a directive from the Pennsylvania Department of Health regarding Pediatric Extended Care Centers in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Please know that we understand the challenges and stress that this prolonged closure has put on our families. Once we receive permission to reopen, we will communicate that as quickly and efficiently as possible.
